Advice Letter 269-W Great Oaks Water Company (U-162-W) To the California Public Utilities Commission

Great Oaks Water Company (Great Oaks) hereby submits this Tier 1 advice letter to update and amend its Rule 19 pertaining to Service to Separate Premises and Multiple Units, and Resale of Water to comply with new law in California. The following tariff sheets are provided with this Advice Letter 269-W:

Background

On September 25, 2016, Governor Brown approved Senate Bill (SB) 7, which, among other things, added Article 5 (commencing with Section 537) to Chapter 8 of Division 1 of the Water Code, relating to housing, individual water meters, and submeters. Section 537.1(a) of the Water Code provides:

Each water purveyor that sells, leases, rents, furnishes, or delivers water service to a newly constructed multiunit residential structure or newly constructed mixed-use residential and commercial structure for which an application for a water connection, or more than one connection, is submitted after January 1, 2018, shall require a measurement of the quantity of water supplied to each individual residential dwelling unit as a condition of water service. The measurement may be by individual water meters or submeters.

This new law means that Great Oaks, as a "water purveyor," must require, as a condition of service, that the owner or operator of the newly constructed structure individually meter each residential unit of the multiunit residential mixed residential/commercial structure if the water purveyor elects not to do so.

The proposed amendment/addition to Great Oaks' Rule No. 19 complies with this new legal requirement in all respects.

Requested Action

Great Oaks requests that the Commission authorize it to update and amend its Rule No. 19 with the proposed tariff sheet attached to this Advice Letter.

Tier Designation

This is a Tier 1 Advice Letter under General Order 96-B, as it addresses compliance with a mandatory statute (Industry Rule 7.3.1(3)).

Requested Effective Date

Great Oaks requests that this Advice Letter be approved with an effective date of January 1, 2018.

Notice and Service

This Advice Letter is being served upon the Distribution List provided below.

¹ The term "water purveyor" is defined in Water Code §512 as "any person who furnishes water service to another person."

Protests and Responses

Anyone may protest and respond to this Advice Letter. A Response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the Advice Letter. A Protest objects to the Advice Letter in whole or in part and must set forth specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may be based upon the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the Advice Letter; or
- (2) The relief requested in the Advice Letter would violate a statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies; or
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the Advice Letter contain material error or omissions; or
- (4) The relief requested in the Advice Letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the Advice Letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the Advice Letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the Advice Letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a Protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

Any Protest or Response must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division of the Commission within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter is filed. The Advice Letter process does not provide for any Protests, Responses or other comments, except for a reply by Great Oaks, after the 20 day comment period expires. SERVICE TO SEPARATE PREMISES AND MULTIPLE UNITS, AND RESALE OF WATER

C. Resale of Water

Except by special agreement with the utility, or except as provided in B.2.b. above, no customer shall resell any of the water received from the utility, nor shall such water be delivered to premises other than those specified in such customer's application for service.
