Advice Letter 319-W Great Oaks Water Company (U-162-W) to the California Public Utilities Commission Correcting Errors in Authorized Tariff Page

Great Oaks Water Company (Great Oaks) transmits this Tier 1 advice letter to correct typographical errors on recently approved tariff sheets. The following changes in the tariff schedules applicable to Great Oaks entire service area are proposed:

Summary of Advice Letter 319-W

The California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) recently approved Great Oaks' Advice Letter 316-W-A to establish new rates effective July 1, 2023. Unfortunately, two of the tariff sheets approved by the Commission had inadvertent typographical errors that require correction.

On Tariff Sheet 1045-W, the quantity rate for Schedule No. 3M Irrigation Service should be the same as the quantity rate for Schedule No. 1 General Metered Service. When Advice Letter 316-W was supplemented (Advice Letter 316-W-A), the Schedule No. 3M quantity rate should have been changed to the revised quantity rate from Schedule No. 1 but was not. This advice letter cures this inadvertent error.

The same inadvertent error was made on Schedule No. 6, and this advice letter also cures that error.

Other Pending Advice Letters

Advice Letters 317-W and 318-W are pending.

No Effect on Water Service

This Advice Letter filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

Effective Dates

Great Oaks requests that the corrected tariff sheet and table of contents all have the same effective dates as the tariff sheets being corrected – July 1, 2023.

Tier Designation

This is a Tier 1 Advice Letter pursuant to General Order 96-B, as the requested relief (correction of typographical errors) is to comply with the Commission's approval of Advice Letter 316-W-A.

Notice and Service

Notice is being provided by publishing this Advice Letter on Great Oaks' website (www.greatoakswater.com) and through service upon the Distribution List provided below.

Protests and Responses

Anyone may protest and respond to this Advice Letter. A Response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the Advice Letter. A Protest objects to the Advice Letter in whole or in part and must set forth specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may be based upon the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the Advice Letter; or
- (2) The relief requested in the Advice Letter would violate a statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies; or

- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the Advice Letter contain material error or omissions; or
- (4) The relief requested in the Advice Letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the Advice Letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the Advice Letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the Advice Letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a Protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

Any Protest or Response must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division of the Commission within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter is filed. The Advice Letter process does not provide for any Protests, Responses or other comments, except for a reply by Great Oaks, after the 20-day comment period expires.
