Note 1: In late July of 2022, Great Oaks Water Company (Great Oaks) received an expression of interest from the Kaiser Permanente San Jose Medical Center to buy a small parcel from Great Oaks. The parcel has been owned by Great Oaks for a long period of time and is the location of one of Great Oaks' active groundwater wells.

Great Oaks provided notice to the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) on July 26, 2022. Great Oaks also posted the notice to NAHC on its Tribal Lands Transfer Policy webpage.¹ Great Oaks did not receive a response from NAHC to the notice and subsequently sent a notice to the Ohlone Indian Tribe on August 26, 2022.

Subsequently, Great Oaks decided not to sell the parcel.

Note 2: Great Oaks has not received any response from The Ohlone Indian Tribe.
