Great Oaks Water Company Customers Achieve Conservation Goals in June and July

For the second consecutive month, Great Oaks' customers have achieved their conservation goals. In June of 2022, Great Oaks customers used 15% less water than they did in June of 2019. In July, the results were even more impressive, as customers used 19% less water than in July of 2019. Great Oaks thanks its customers for their conservation efforts. We know it's not easy to conserve and we are grateful for your ongoing efforts.

In June of 2021, the Board of the Santa Clara Valley Water District declared a water shortage emergency and called for mandatory conservation at least equal to 15% off of 2019 usage. Despite a record dry start to 2022 and recent hot and dry weather, our customers have responded, and the results show their success.

The State of California has also called for voluntary reductions in water usage equal to at least 15% off of water usage in 2020. In June and July of this year, Great Oaks' customers met these goals as well, conserving 19% in June and 23% in July.

Great Oaks will continue to encourage conservation by its customers during these dry times. Thank you again for conserving water.
