

CHLORINATING WATER IN GREAT OAKS SERVICE AREA

On July 31, 2019, Great Oaks Water Company (GOWC), with the guidance and approval of the State Water Resources Control Board Division of Drinking Water (DDW), will begin low-level disinfection using sodium hypochlorite (liquid chlorine) in the water coming from our wells in Coyote Valley to all areas of our service area. This action is being taken because GOWC is putting a new section of pipeline into service. The disinfection process will continue for three months to insure all of the water coming to our customers is healthy and safe. After three months, GOWC will review the effects of the chlorine disinfection with DDW to determine if any further disinfection is necessary. GOWC will update this site with new and additional information as it becomes available.
